In the month of June, the State Hospital announced the arrival of Covid vaccines in Rumbek. We were happy to receive the good news. Our school was one of the first institutes to go for vaccination. Initially some people were concerned, but we were encouraged by our PHCC staff members who were the first in the queue. The staff in both the Primary and Secondary Schools, the interns,

the cooks, and people from the local community working in the compound followed shortly afterwards. We now feel protected. We are grateful to the Government for their work. We are looking forward to the second dose in August. In the meantime, we are encouraging others to go for the vaccine themselves.

This month we celebrated our Nurse's Day, which was postponed because some of our nurses and staff had been on annual leave. We had Mass celebrated in the Clinic by Father Alan.
