community were able to return within the first week and class is well underway for them. Our seventy-eight students, boys and girls, are now filling in their government forms for their pending examinations. We wish all our



students a happy stay and success in their forth coming exams.

In the month of October, we said our goodbyes to the last group of interns who had returned to Loreto Rumbek in April to help when Covid 19 broke out. We are thankful to them for all their efforts and hard work. Their assistance to the medical staff in providing basic health care and awareness campaigns for the community was much appreciated.
